A. PETRAUSKAS MUSEUM AND CRAFT CENTER

KOMARAI MANOR




GPS: 55.78192, 24.830055 (WGS)


The manor house, the residential building of servants (oficina), creamery, brewery and warehouse have survived into the present. The manor building has been one-storey and reflected the Classicism style until the second half of the 19th century. The house had 26 rooms of miscellaneous purpose, shape and size. It was surrounded by the English-style Park, covering the area of 2 ha. There were many works of art and a library of 5,000 volumes inside. Currently the Manor is owned by Nijole Milakniene, the granddaughter of Bogdanas Komaras.

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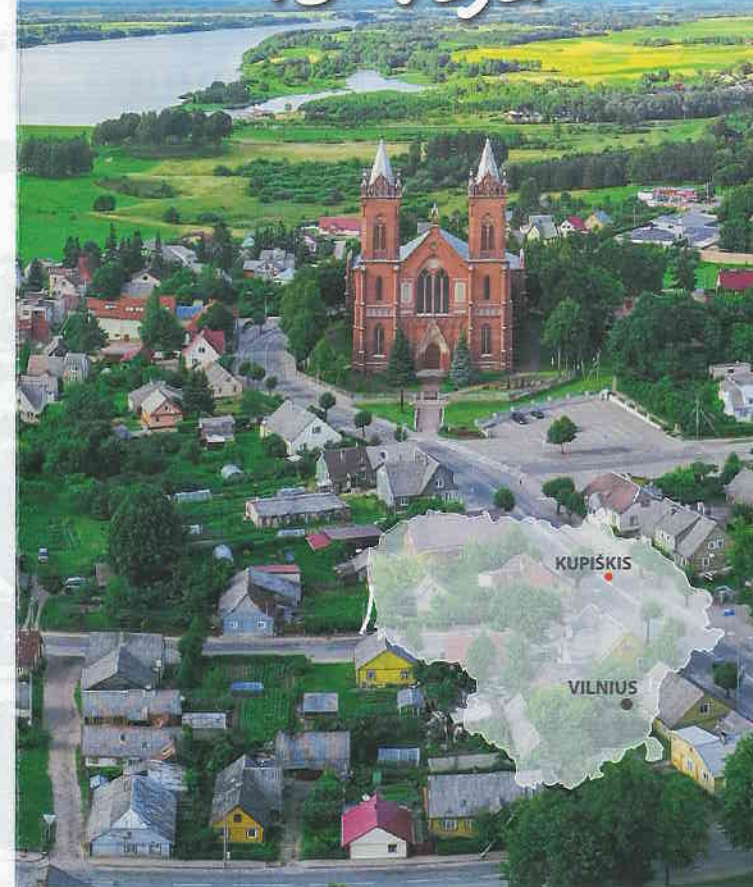

1. THE ASCENSION CHURCH OF KUPISKIS



The first thing you see, as entering the town on whichever way, are its' red brick towers. The Church is a monument of the Neo-Gothic style, hall type (60 x 43 m), built of bricks, and has two sacristies, 3 naves and 5 altars inside. Its' arches are ferroconcrete. The roof is adorned by 22 crosses. The Church was built in 1900 - 1914 and is one of the largest in Lithuania.

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2. KUPISKIS LAGOON AND ISLAND MOTHER-IN-LAW'S TONGUE (UOSVES LIEZUVIS)



Dendrological park was founded in the island "Mother-in-Law's Tongue" (Uosves liezuvis), in the fourth largest artificial water pond in Lithuania. The pond covers an area of 828 hectares and it is 25 kilometers long. In the park you can find more than 100 different kinds of plants. The landscape around the Kupiskis lagoon is no less impressive than its size. The water sides are equipped with nice beaches, recreation areas, fireplaces, summerhouses, parks. Every year the town holds annual festivals like "Tourism opening season", "Crayfish catching and cooking competitions", fishermen competitions, Lagoon Regatta, National Open Triathlon Championship.

3. SMALL ARCHITECTURE "THE OPEN-AIR MUSEUM" OF H. ORAKAUSKAS SCULPTURES IN THE TOWN



This tourist route revealing the distinctive face of the town. Currently the town is adorned with over 30 pieces of art of this sculptor. It starts with wooden sculptures and ends metal plastic works such as "Kupiskenai' Weddings", "The World Tree of the Balts", "The guest", "Levuo and Kupa", "Descending angel", etc. You need to come, see and feel the distinctive spaces of the town as it is impossible to describe everything here.

4. KUPISKIS ETHNOGRAPHIC MUSEUM

5. THE FORMER JEWISH SYNAGOGUE (now - Public library)



In 2004 here was a memorial plate for Jews killed in 1941 in Kupiskis opened. It lists all 816 names of killed people. Names were carefully collected by regional researcher Stefanija Glemzaitė and her assistants. Name list was added by relatives and descendants of victims.

6. KUPISKIS MOUND



According to historians, the Mound has hidden a wooden community castle-hiding place, which was the earliest germ of the future township. In ancient times the Selonians (the Balts tribe) have lived in Kupiskis surroundings, which were their southern lands.

7. PALEVENE ENSEMBLE OF ST. DOMINIC'S CHURCH AND THE DOMINICAN MONASTERY



It is the only exponent of the Late Baroque in Higher Lithuania (Aukštaitija). The history of Palevene Monastery goes back to 1676, when the first Dominican monks, financially supported by Laurynas Mykolas Odlanickis, have settled there. The Ensemble consisted of many brick and wooden buildings of different purposes such as two granaries, stable with carriage house, cowshed, water well.

8. ADOMYNE MANOR



The Adomyne Manor is a beautiful and rare wooden architectural monument of the Romantic Classicism. It is included into the Heritage Registry of the Lithuanian Culture. It is considered that the Manor was built by local craftsmen at the beginning of the 19th century. Currently the Manor has been restored. Adomyne's community is organizing various educational programs.
